CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Shall be in accordance with Bowls Australia Laws of the Game.

1. FORMAT – Knock-out
2. SCORING – Four bowls, 2 sets of 9 ends. In the event of participants being tied at one set each, then a third 3 ends “sudden death” set is played to determine the winner.
3. DEAD ENDS – There shall be no dead-ends (jack to be repositioned) in accordance to Law 31(b).
4. MAT – The right to play first shall be determined in accordance with the laws of the game except that at the start of the second or a subsequent set the winner of the previous set may transfer the right to play first to his opponent.

The start of the second or a subsequent set is not the beginning of a new match and the match and the mat shall be placed in accordance with Law 51(b).
5. VISIT THE HEAD – Players will not be permitted to visit the head until after the delivery of their second bowl.
6. FORFEITS – Match awarded to opposing player.
7. BOWLS TESTING – In line with the rules laid down by Bowls Australia.
8. ATTIRE – As per the Bowls Queensland dress regulations
9. TRIAL ENDS – Two trial ends with four bowls will be permitted prior to the commencement of each match.

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to ordinary female financial members of clubs affiliated with Bowls Queensland.

Any dual state member who has participated in another state indoor qualifying competition shall not be eligible. Any player found to be in contravention of these conditions shall be disqualified and the last player defeated will be re-instated into the match.
