



## ***UMPIRE ACCREDITATION PROCEDURES***

### ***LEVEL 3***

The procedure for accreditation of Level 3 Umpires adopted by Bowls Australia is as follows:

#### **Level 3 Accreditation**

- The State/Territory Umpires Committee will recommend the candidate for advancement to Level 3.
- The candidate will submit a logbook or other acceptable evidence of officiating as a Level 2 Umpire.
- The candidate will have demonstrated and continue to demonstrate a high level of competence as a level 2 umpire.
- The candidate shall demonstrate by examination knowledge of the International Laws of the Sport of Bowls. (pass mark 90%)
- The National Rules Committee will grant National Umpire accreditation as a Level 3.
- Accreditation as a level 3 International Umpire shall be valid for the term of the accreditation (currently five years).

The procedure for re-accreditation of Level 3 Umpires adopted by Bowls Australia is as follows:

#### **Level 3 Re-Accreditation**

- The umpire will have maintained his/her accreditation as a level 2 National Umpire.
- The umpire will produce a logbook or other acceptable evidence to show that, in addition to the hours required for re-accreditation as a Level 2 National Umpire, he/she has officiated at events at International level for a total of at least 20 hours over the last 5 years.
- The candidate shall demonstrate by examination knowledge of the International Laws of the Sport of Bowls. (pass mark 90%)
- The National Rules Committee will grant re-accreditation as a Level 3 National Umpire.
- Re-accreditation as a level 3 International Umpire shall be valid for the term of the accreditation (currently five years).
